Find a quiet, well-lit location and minimize distractions in the video frame.

Be prepared with a copy of your resume/cv, relevant notes, and questions you may have about the company, role, and team. Remember, this is also your opportunity to interview us!



Speak clearly into the microphone, pay attention to your volume, actively engage, and maintain eye contact with your interviewers.
